## RoHS

Regulation for chemicals according to RoHS directive 2011/65/EU incl. 2015/863/EU

The restriction of certain hazardous substances according to the RoHS directive 2002/95/EG has become effective at the 1st of July 2006 and applies to the substances lead, cadmium, mercury, hexavalent chromium, PBB's and PBDE's.

This directive was replaced at 1st of January 2013 by the RoHS directive 2011/65/EU.

Z+F declares the conformity of the product ranges Z+F Ferrules, Z+F Terminals, Z+F Tools, Z+F Machines and Z+F Laser Measurement Systems and Z+F Time Relay in terms of the above mentioned RoHS directive 2011/65/EU (including the amending directive RL2015/863/EU) and the electronic legislation.

Concerning the WEEE-directives, Z+F does not manufacture any electrical or electronical devices which are for exclusive or sporadic utilization in private households. We oblige ourselves to create a reasonable possibility for returning and disposing devices from other utilizations than private households which were put in circulation after the 13th of August 2005.

## REACH

SVHCs (substances of very high concern) are chemical compounds which were identified under the REACH regulation with specific hazardous properties and are regularly listed and published by the ECHA.

Concerning the European REACH regulation we are acting accordingly and with the necessary care.

However, we do not supply chemicals, substances or syntheses. We do supply products, to which during the production process a specific form is given, that affects the function in a stronger measure than the chemical composition. Within the intended way of using these products, they do not emit any substances and do not contain any dangerous substances beyond the limit of 0,1%.

According to Article 33 of the REACH regulation and the registered substances of very high concern with all enhancements of ECHA of 16th January 2020 following from Article 59 of the REACH regulation, we shall inform our customers before every shipment about any article that contains a SVHC above 0.1% w/w.

Furthermore we can assure that we are in a constant dialogue with our suppliers in the supply chain. In addition to that our suppliers are committed to inform us immediately, if the REACH Conformity cannot be guaranteed anymore.
